

Marginalized Adolescents Benefit from Adolescent Friendly Health Services at Mulago Adolescent Clinic

UYDEL organizes adolescent orientation health care visits to Mulago Adolescent Clinic as one of its initiative to promote the health of adolescents and their access to comprehensive Adolescent Sexual reproductive health (ASRH) care. On 23 August 2013 , a group of 23 out of school adolescents from UYDEL Kamwokya drop in centre in kifumbira slum area were referred and had an interface dialogue with specialist doctors in Mulago. They all benefitted from a range of health services, particularly; STI diagnosis and treatment, HIV Counseling and testing, ART, counselling including other medical examination. The treatment services were provided at free cost. This development has enabled marginalized adolescents to access comprehensive curative and preventive health care services who are unable to access the expensive health facilities. The adolescent health clinic at mulago operates every Friday of the week.
